- The Gallery reserves the right to cancel or terminate a course, or refuse enrolment as permitted by law. In the event that a course is cancelled by the Gallery, a full credit note or refund will be offered. Conditions apply.
- Enrolment in any course is conditional upon receipt of full course fee, unless otherwise negotiated.
- In the event the participant is unable to complete a course for a valid reason, the Gallery will offer 80% of the remaining fee as credit towards a future art class.
- Credit notes will only be valid for a period of 12 months.
- Due to committed costs for each course, the Gallery is unable to refund or credit casual absences during an established art course.
- Where applicable, materials lists will be supplied at the time of booking. In some cases basic consumables are supplied. Any additional materials must be purchased by the course participant at local art suppliers or from the Gallery Shop.
- Due to WHS issues, all participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the course, especially if damage to clothing is a concern. Participants will not be allowed to enter a class wearing thongs or open-toed footwear.
