Hannah Batty

Born in New Zealand, Hannah Batty attended The University of Canterbury in Christchurch studying Fine Arts with a focus on drawing and mixed media. In 2012, she relocated to Newcastle where she currently lives. While she has already participated in a variety of group shows, her first solo show, *All The Rage Back Home*, was staged this year at Art Systems Wickham.

Batty's practice involves methodically and obsessively producing geometric form through drawing. Primarily executed by hand on paper, the building

of forms and investigating the relationships that arise has become a form of personal cartography. Most recently, her work has been influenced by patterns in architecture as well as by the way in which tessellation and different materials affect geometric form. The continuative nature of pattern and sense of regeneration are important for her, contextualising each work as part of a greater body of investigation.
