ARTMAKING WHAT YOU NEED



- Paper
- Texta
- Pencils
- Tape or glue
- Scissors
- Cardboard (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Trace around your hand and the hands of other family members.
- 2 Cut them out
- 3 Look at maps of where you were born and where your family members are from.
- 4 Make a drawing inspired by these places. Including landmarks like lakes, rivers, beaches, or hills, mountains, roads and trees. Collage these drawings onto a piece of paper or cardboard and use as your background.
- 5 Decorate and glue the hands to the background.
